In this STEM-related program, students explore the use of light as a communication method and make real-world connections with artifacts throughout the museum to see how light and sound have been used historically to communicate. Students test this knowledge by building their own light communication device. This program is tied to the Grade 1 Science curriculum for Unit 2: Can You See the Light?

Cost: \$5.00 per student

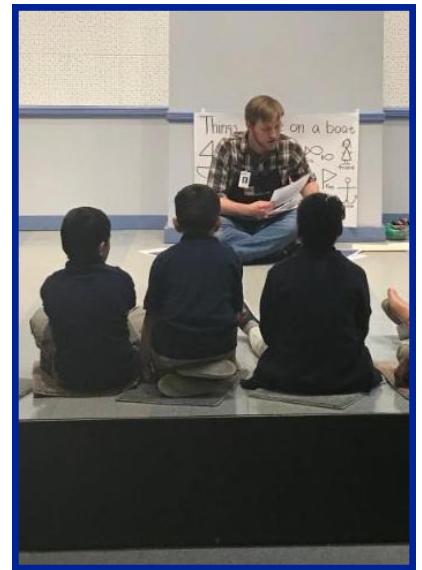
