Self-guided Tour

Using free materials provided by the Maryland Science Center, students will engage in hands-on investigations of force and motion during a self-guided tour of the Newton's Alley and Science & Main exhibits. Teachers will also receive resources to help students apply what they learn when they return to the classroom. This experience is tied to the Kindergarten science curriculum for Unit 1: Ramps and Pathways.

Cost: All Maryland students and chaperones visit the exhibit halls for free.

There is no maximum class size for this experience.

Preferred chaperone to student ratio is one adult per ten students.
